PROPOSITION 3 WILL:

- Authorize **\$980 million for grants to 13 California children's hospitals:**
Children's Hospital Oakland will use its \$98 million grant to help rebuild the hospital here in Oakland.
- Provide **funding to improve, expand and seismically upgrade** California's children hospitals, and allow the hospitals to purchase new medical breakthrough technologies.

PLEASE VOTE YES BECAUSE:

- **Prop. 3 will save kids' lives everyday.**
- Prop. 3 funds will help California's children's hospitals **build more bed capacity** to better meet the needs of California's expanding pediatric population, projected to grow by 35 percent over the next two decades.
- Prop. 3 funds will help California's children's hospitals **purchase medical breakthrough technologies and special equipment** so they can better treat kids with serious and life-threatening conditions like cancer, leukemia, heart defects, sickle cell anemia, cystic fibrosis, diabetes, major traumas and premature birth.
- Prop. 3 funds will help **make California's children's hospitals safer.** Many children's hospitals must upgrade their facilities to meet stringent new earthquake standards.

Prop. 3 is not a tax measure;

the bond's cost represents less than 1/10th of one percent of the state's annual budget (or \$1.75 a year for each Californian for 30 years).
